v.31 Why was John to baptize Jesus? A: vv.31,32,34

v.33 According to this passage, are being "baptized with water" and being "baptized with the Spirit" one & the same thing? A: vv.26,31,33

Why did the Spirit come down in a visible form?

v.34 What was John's testimony about Jesus?

What does it mean to be the "Son" of God? A: see v.18 Is this different from being a "human" v.13 and a "child" of God v.12?

vv.1-34 What is the main issue in this passage? A: to establish the deity of Jesus Christ - His God-hood

How is Jesus' deity established in this passage? A: by the

- 1. testimony of the author
- 2. testimony of John the Baptist
- 3. the coming of the Holy Spirit in a visible form
- 4. testimony of O.T. Scriptures see v.23 "Lord" =Jehovah= Jesus

BIG IDEA: <u>The Book of John is making some very serious claims about who Jesus</u> <u>was/is</u>. The Jews of that time did not understand, recognize, or receive Jesus as God, but instead rejected Him as the Christ, the Messiah, the Anointed One. Either these claims are wildly false or they are the truth. Either Jesus really is God, the source for eternal life, the sacrifice to take away sin or He is not. As we continue our study of the Book of John in the coming weeks, we will be considering further claims about Jesus. Hopefully, these studies will help you to formulate an informed opinion on the claims of Christianity.
